

WCCYM and YFC Leadership Programme

From September 2016 to April 2017, WCCYM (West Cambridge Christian Youth Ministries) and Cambridge & District Youth for Christ will be running a Leadership Programme for a group of 16-21 year olds. The purpose of the Leadership programme is to help young people explore leadership and develop their own gifts in this area, in a Christian context. The main focus is character, and young people who are part of the programme will be encouraged to be open and honest about themselves, as part of the group discussion times. The programme will be held in Comberton and will consist of three overnight residentials (dates to be confirmed), monthly evening meetings, and will finish with a celebration day in April. The cost will be £80 for the whole course – this includes the residentials, monthly sessions (including a meal each month), and all the resources, including a book on leadership. It can be paid in instalments if preferred. Your church may be able to help with the cost of the course, or you can speak to WCCYM or YFC if this is not possible.



Each person on the Leadership Programme will have a mentor that they meet with on a monthly basis, and they will be involved in practical leadership activities within WCCYM, YFC and/or their local church.

You will need to return your application form and give us details of two people who can provide references for you by Monday 27th June. A group of up to 12 young people will then be selected to join the programme starting in September. You will need to commit to the full length of the course.
