

How much does it cost?

Soul Survivor charge an entrance fee to the festival. This gives you access to all events, gigs, etc for the week. There are three booking deadlines, so the cost will depend on when you book by:

Book with WCCYM...

By 30 th January	Entrance fee is £94
By 1 st May	Entrance fee is £104
After 1 st May	Entrance fee is £114

The cost of the food and transport will be an additional £45.00.

Cheques should be made payable to WCCYM.

Payments can be made in instalments. Contact WCCYM if you would like to do this.

Once you have booked, we cannot get a refund on the entrance fee, but we are happy for you to pay in instalments until June, to spread out the cost (but you will be committing to pay for the entrance fee which is non-refundable).
